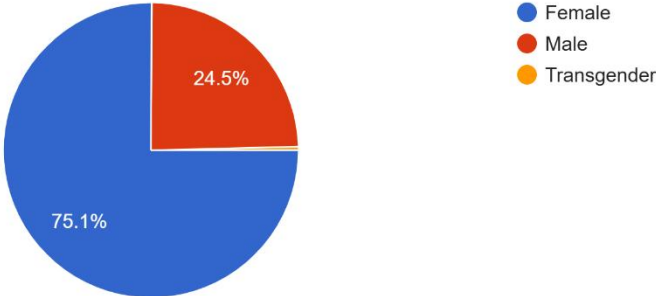

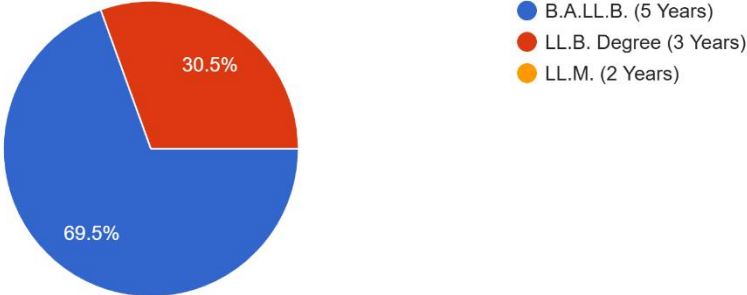

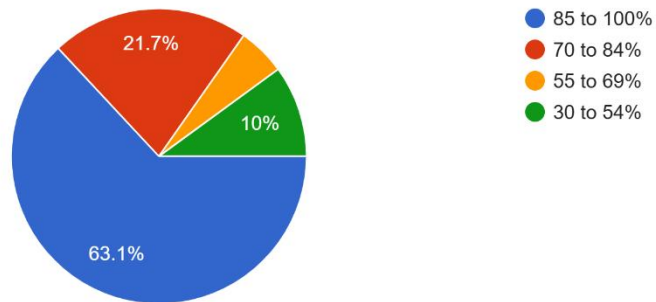

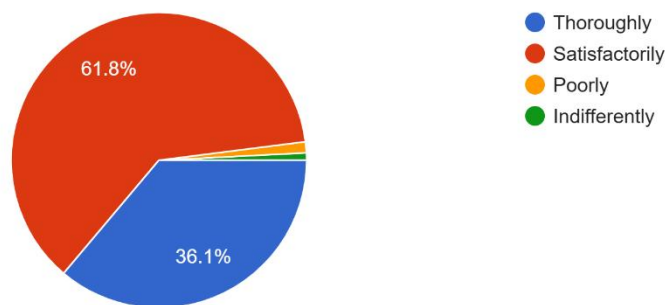
How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

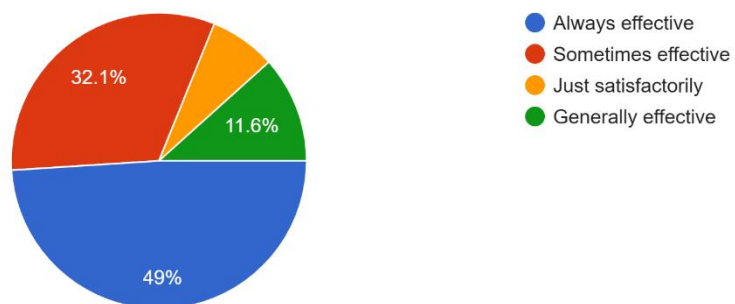
How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

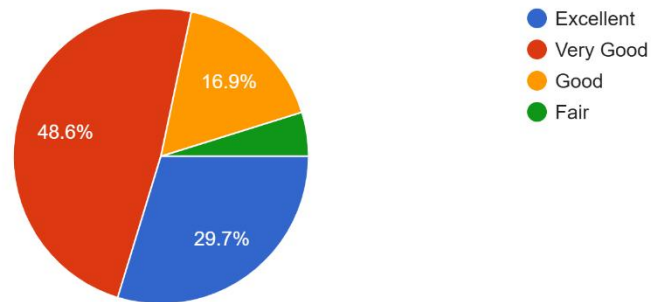
How well were the teachers able to communicate?

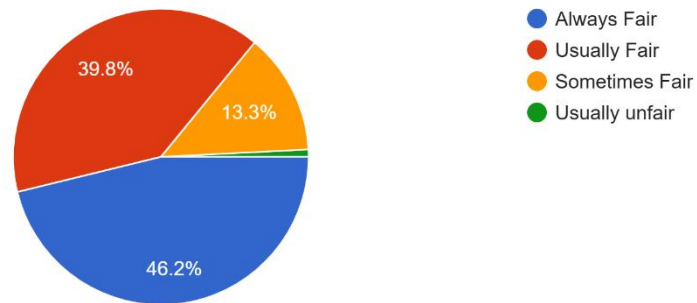
The teacher's approach to teaching can be best described as

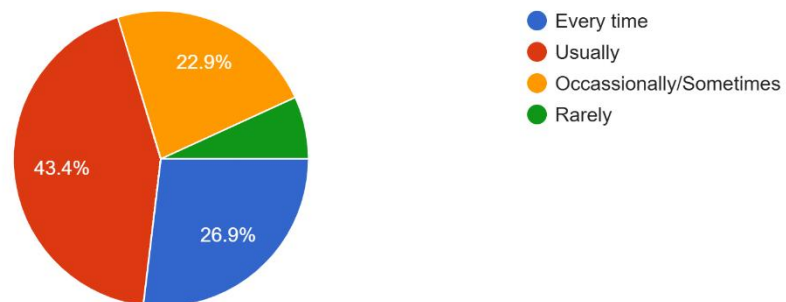

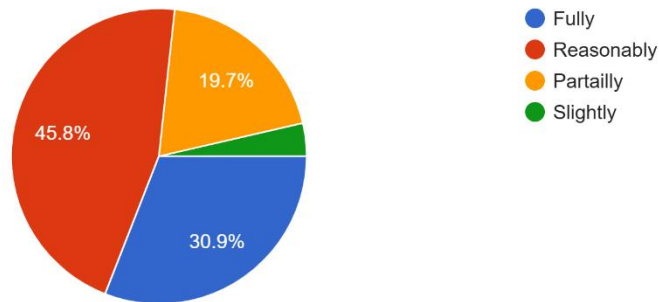

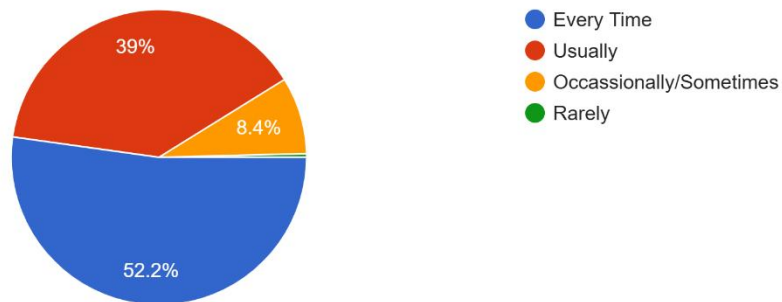

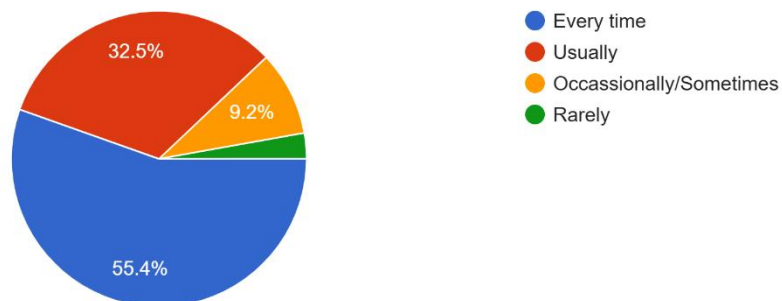

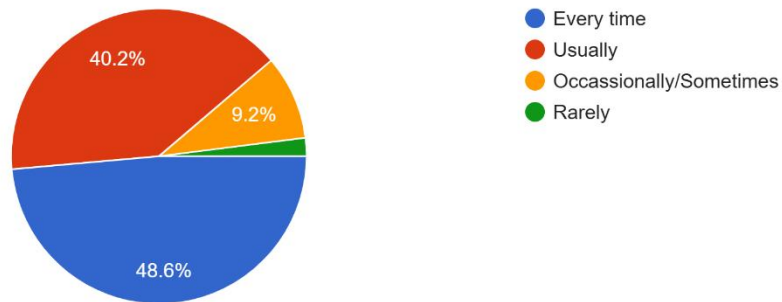

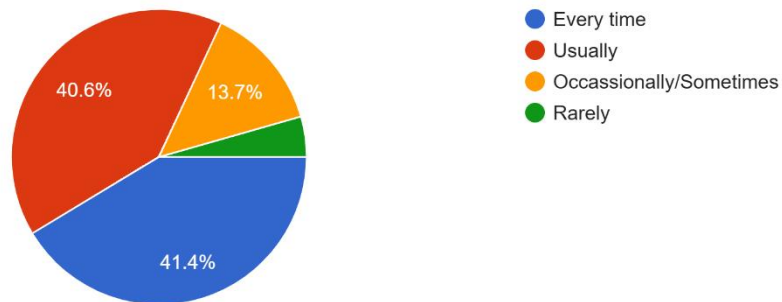

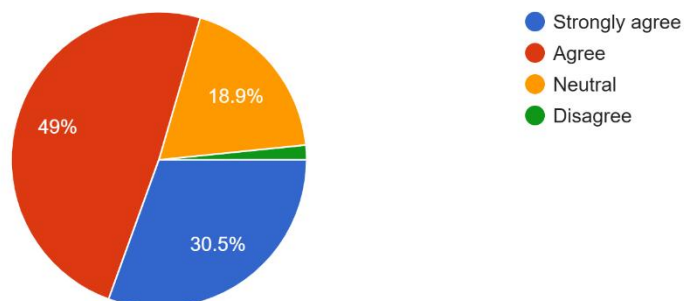

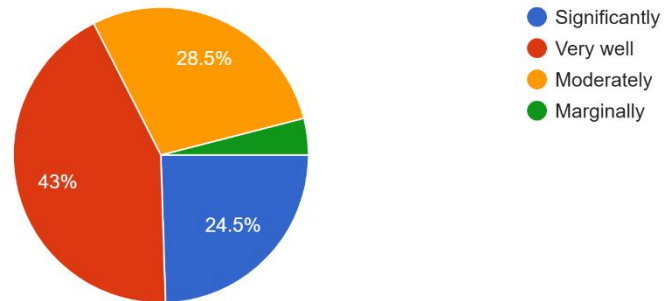

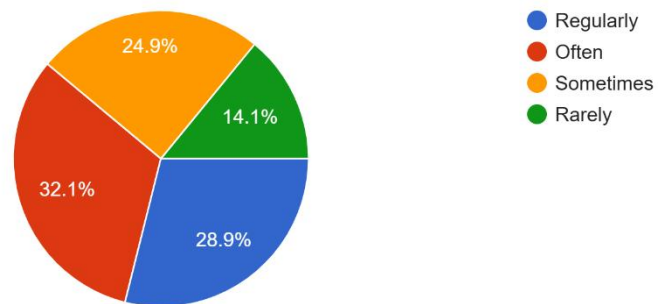

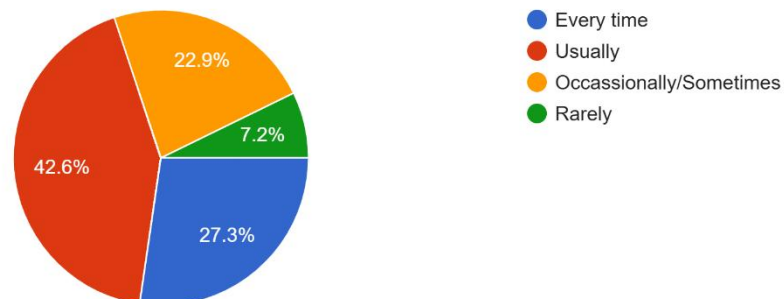

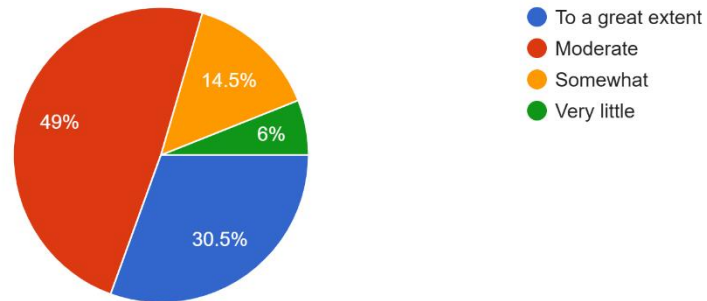
Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

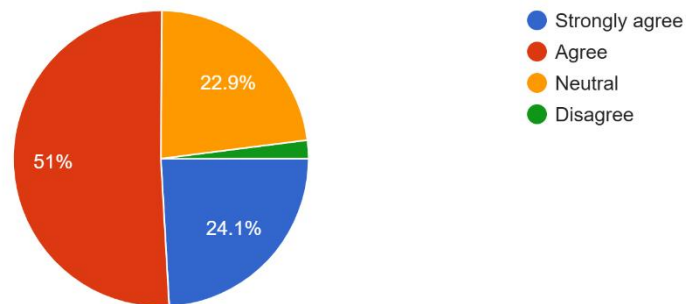

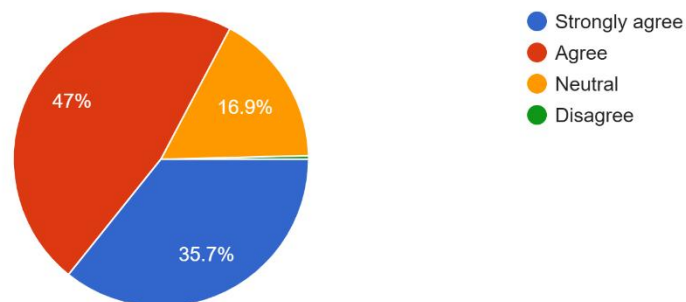

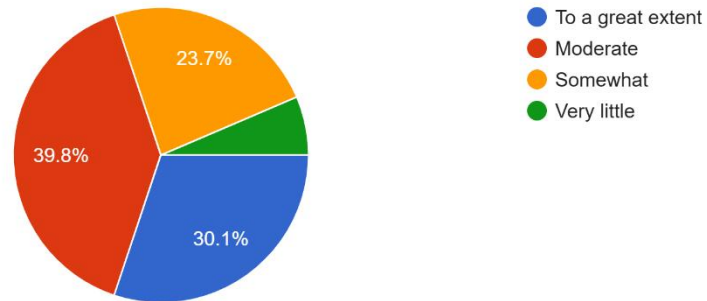

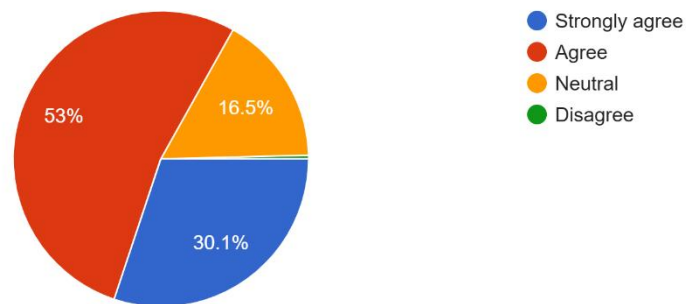

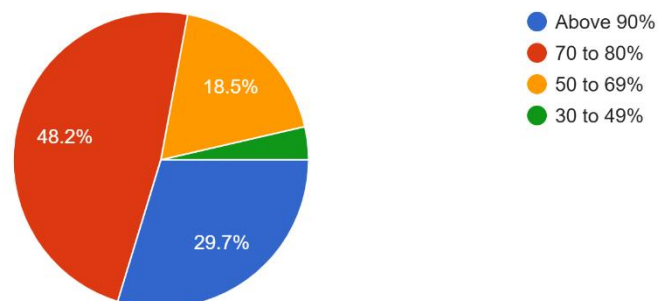
The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good.

ANALYSIS OF THE STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY (SSS) 2023 – 2024

Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is a compulsory criterion set by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). It is also a pre-qualifier for Assessment and Accreditation of the institution. From the year 2017, the NAAC has endeavoured to conduct a Student Experience Survey, the results of which will go into the accreditation process. The Survey includes 20 competency-based questions, responses to which are given anonymously by students of the institution. This survey corresponds to institute level feedback on infrastructure and learning experience.

The College implemented the SSS by administering a feedback form to the students and the observations/outcome of this SSS is as under:

Many students are of the opinion that the teachers cover almost the whole syllabus, prepare well for the classes, communicate very well and have an excellent approach at teaching whereby they illustrate concepts through examples and applications, by following up every time with the tasks assigned to them, and that 70% - 80% teachers use ICT tools while teaching. With regards to the internal evaluation, many believe that it is always fair and that teachers are usually able to identify the weaknesses and strengths of the students and help the students to overcome the weaknesses and encourage them by providing right level of challenges thereby doing justice to their profession. Many students are of the opinion that teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities. However, most of the students are of the opinion that moderate efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work.

Many students believe the teaching and mentoring process helps them in cognitive, social and emotional growth. Most of the students are of the view that the institute takes active interest in promoting internship, and field visit opportunities. majority of the students are of the opinion that the institution makes effort to engage them in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process. Majority of the students strongly agree that the overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good.

The SSS has brought to the attention of the institution some areas where there is scope enhancement in the quality of education.

Students recommended more endeavours by the institution in the field of internship and placements by aid and collaboration with alumni; and in skill development by organising special guest lectures and classes. There is a need to convey more practical training to the students.
